Nylon Rope	Skin Closures (assorted)
Bungee Cords	Sponge/brush pre-op surgical scrub
1500-10 kilowatt Diesel Generators	Speculum, vaginal disposable plastic
Extension Cords	Alcohol pads
Power Strips	Instant cold packs one time use (the kind for you squeeze for the cold)
Flood Lights	Purell hand sanitizer
Empty Diesel Cans	Ziploc bags (snack, sandwich, and gallon size)
Medical supplies:	Pill bottles
Peroxide	Thermometer
Band-Aids	Thermometer covers (disposable) for oral and ear thermometer
Antibiotic cream	Ace wrap
Surgical Masks	Small scissors and tweezers
Diapers all sizes	Toothbrushes, sample size
Clorox wipes	toothpaste
Alcohol wipes	Travel soaps, shampoo, and
Garbage Bags	toothpaste (the kind from hotels)

Bandage, cling	Generic medications are fine and much cheaper. Please do not bring or send expired medications.
Tape, bandage (assorted)	Tylenol (Acetaminophen)
Bandaid	Ibuprofen/Advil
Gauze	Aspirin
Tongue depressors	Vitamins (adult and children)
Basin	Calcium tablets
Blood pressure cuff	Vitamin E tablets
Stethoscope	Vitamin C tablets
Thermometer	Hydrocortisone cream
Ear Syringe	Antibacterial ointment (like Neosporin)
Otoscope tips	Monistat cream (or generic)
K-Y jelly	Anti-fungal cream (Lotisone or generic)

Liquid hand sanitizer

Benadryl (liquid for kids and pills for adults)
Any pills and liquid for cold/cough/sinus
Children's chewable and liquid- Motrin and Tylenol
Children's cold/cough medication (in chewable and liquid)
Nix or Rid (for lice)
Visine and/or allergy eye drops
Ear wax removal drops (Debrox or Cerumenex)
Tums, Gas-ex, Pepcid, Zantac, Mylanta (drops for infants)
Immodium or other anti-diarrheal medication

Prescription medications:
Antibiotics: Amoxicillin, Erythromycin, Bactrim, Cephalexin, Metronidazole
Scabies medication (Lindane)
Prednisone
Parasite medication (Mebendazole)
Asthma inhalers (Albuterol, etc.)
